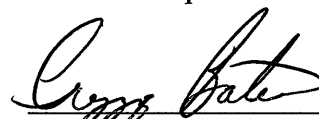
Thereupon, Willard Payne moved to approve Ordinance No. 116-4 as written. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
