Karyl Rice moved to waive the oral reading of the October 20, 2003 minutes and approve as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

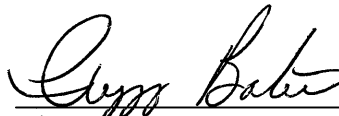
There was no old business to come before the council.
