Karyl Rice moved to waive the oral reading of the November 17, 2003 minutes and approve as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

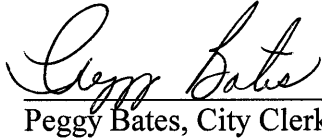
There was no old business before the council.
