There was no old business before the council.

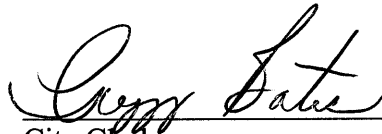

Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with the following vote recorded: Mayor Hayes, yes; Willard Payne, yes; Mike Dickens, yes; Rosemary Metcalf, yes; Karyl Rice, yes and Jim Phillips, yes. Thereupon, Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 67-6 as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

With no other business before the council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Jim Phillips seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
