Willard Payne moved to waive the oral reading of the June 21, 2004 minutes and approve as printed.

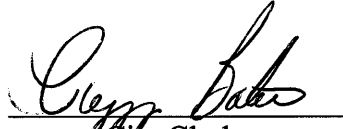
There was no old business to come before the council.

A resolution was introduced adopting the Shelby County Alabama Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan. Rosemary Metcalf moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Karyl Rice announced that the Pelham City Council will hold a public hearing July 19, 2004 at 7 p.m. to consider Ordinance #135-155 changing the present zoning of A-1 Agricultural to R-1 Residential Zoning. The property is located in South half of Section 1, Township 20 South, and Range 2 West, approximately 68 acres, applicant – Gary L. Thompson.
