

The Pelham City Council convened at 7 p.m., Monday, August 16, 2004. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Karyl Rice led the invocation.

Willard Payne moved to waive the reading of the August 2, 2004 minutes and approve as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

There was no old business to come before the council.

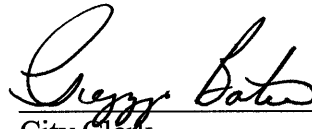
During new business, two resolutions were introduced, one authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with ALDOT concerning the intersection of Valleydale Road and US 31 and one stating the terms of the agreement. Karyl Rice made the following public hearing announcement: A public hearing will be held September 13 at 7 p.m. to consider Ordinance No. 135-156 changing the present zoning of A-1 Agricultural to R-1 Residential on property located on SC 336. The applicant is Double Mountain Lane, LLC (Al Knight & Alan Burns).

Mayor Hayes announced that the Pelham City Council would meet at 7 p.m. on August 24 at Pelham City Hall to certify the election totals.
