

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m. Monday, October 18, 2004. Council President Mike Dickens called the meeting to order and asked Willard Payne to lead the invocation.

Mike Dickens asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Rosemary Metcalf moved to approve the October 4, 2004 minutes as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no old business to come before the council.

During new business Ordinance No. 135-157 was presented, amending Section One of the zoning ordinance prohibiting parking motor vehicles, boats or trailers in the front yard of residentially zoned property, except upon the paved driveway required and installed according to the requirements of the Code of Ordinances, City of Pelham, Alabama. Willard Payne moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Karyl Rice seconded the motion, and a roll call vote was taken with the following vote recorded: Yeas: Mike Dickens, Willard Payne, Karyl Rice, Rosemary Metcalf and Bob Sullivan; Nays: none. Thereupon, Willard Payne moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-157 as presented. Bob Sullivan seconded the motion, and it passed with a vote of four to one with Karyl Rice abstaining.

With no other business before the council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 7:02 p.m.
