President Dickens asked that the record show all members of the council present.

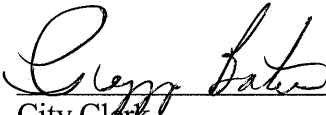

During old business, a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-160 amending the text of the City of Pelham Zoning Ordinance to specify what type exteriors are allowed on buildings in commercial districts. No one spoke against the ordinance. Council Member Robert Sullivan moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-160 as presented. Council Member Willard Payne seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

During new business, an ABC application and resolution was presented for applicants Kinnari Kothari Modi and Prakash P. Modi for 050 Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) under the Trade Name of Deep Country Grocery & Deli located at 3118 Highway 52. Council Member Rosemary Metcalf moved to approve the application and resolution as presented. Council Member Karyl Rice seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

An ABC application and resolution was presented for applicant Hooters of Pelham, LLC for 020 Restaurant Retail Liquor license under the trade name of Hooters located at 400 Cahaba Valley Road. Mason Davis spoke on behalf of the restaurant. Council Member Rosemary Metcalf moved to approve the application and resolution as presented. Council Member Willard Payne seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

With no other business before the council, Council Member Rosemary Metcalf moved to adjourn. Council Member Karyl Rice seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:08 p.m.
