MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING**

Council President Mike Dickens called the meeting to order. Karyl Rice led the invocation.

Mike Dickens asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Rosemary Metcalf moved to waive the oral reading of the April 3, 2006 minutes and approve as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion. Mike Dickens asked for a vote on the motion to approve; on voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Hayes read a proclamation proclaiming April Sexual Assault Awareness Month on behalf of SafeHouse.

There was no old business to come before the council.

During new business, Mike Dickens introduced a resolution accepting a bid for a Toro Groundskeeper 4500-D rotary rough mower for Ballantrae Golf Club from Jerry Pate Turf and Irrigation, Inc., for a cost of \$43,471.19. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented, and Robert Sullivan seconded the motion. Mike Dickens asked for a vote on the motion to approve; on voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

A resolution was introduced to consider an ABC application for 020 Restaurant Retail Liquor for applicant FOJ Enterprises, L.L.C., trade name Sol Azteca located at 2698 Pelham Parkway. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented, and Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion. Mike Dickens asked for a vote on the motion to approve; on voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

A resolution was presented for 011 Lounge Retail Liquor Class II (Package) for applicant N & N Foodmart L.L.C., trade name N & N Foodmart Package Store, 050 Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) and 070 Retail Table Wine (Off Premises Only) for applicant N & N Foodmart L.L.C trade name N & N Foodmart II located at 1286 Highway 52 East. Willard Payne moved to approve the applications as presented, and Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion. Mike Dickens asked for a vote on the motion to approve; on voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

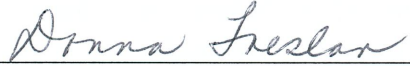

Mike Dickens asked for a vote on the motion to approve; on voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

A resolution was presented to consider the ABC application for 140 Special Events Retail for applicant Favero, L.L.C., trade name Pollo Volador located at 557 Cahaba Valley Road. Mike Dickens stated that the council had several concerns with safety issues and zoning with regard to parking. Rosemary Metcalf moved to deny the application as presented, and Robert Sullivan seconded the motion. Mike Dickens asked for a vote on the motion to approve; on voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

A resolution was presented to consider the ABC application for 140 Special Events Retail for applicant 2 Pesos Mexican Café, Inc., trade name 2 Pesos Mexican Cafe located at 201 Southgate Drive. Mike Dickens stated that the council had several concerns with safety issues and zoning with regard to parking. Robert Sullivan moved to deny the application as presented, and Karyl Rice seconded the motion. Mike Dickens asked for a vote on the motion to approve; on voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

Fire Chief Gary Waters introduced 15 new personnel currently going through training in the fire department.
