NEW BUSINESS

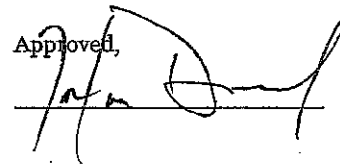
- Christmas Decorations were chosen.
