OLD BUSINESS

- **I-65 Landscaping Options** – Mr. Daniel presented photos and information on how to proceed on this project (Notes and photos attached). The city will need to work on a plan to provide maintenance to the area as needed and obtain the correct permit through the state. HE also mentioned there are grants available to help the Board offset the cost of the project. Ms. Holly will contact the Council to bring them up to date on our plans for the landscaping project.
- **Arbor Day 2018** – A proclamation for Arbor Day will be presented at the April 16th council meeting and received by the Beautification Board members. Ms. Holly will reach out to the Pelham Reporter to do a story on Arbor Day. Mrs. Ramirez looked into Willow Oak trees to plant in celebration of Arbor Day on April 27th. After consulting with Stuart Meyers of Meyer's Nursery the board can purchase an approximate 8ft tall Willow Oak for \$215 with less than a week turn around. The city council will need to provide the new tree's location.
