The meeting was called to order.

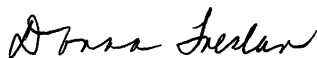
Rosemary Metcalf moved to approve the February 4, 2008 work session minutes as written, and Willard Payne seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.
