Karyl Rice distributed material concerning the National League of Cities Prescription Discount Card Program. After discussion, the clerk was asked to place a resolution on the next agenda stating the city's intent to participate. Distribution locations will be determined.

Bill Meadows commented on the request for funding from Shelby County DHR which was discussed at the previous meeting. He will follow-up with DHR to provide them with additional resource information.

The council discussed Shelby County's proposal to partner with them regarding the purchase and development of property on Highway 31(former Wal-Mart) and decided to decline the opportunity.
