The council meet to discuss Mayor Murphy's proposed FY2011 operating and capital budgets for the various departments within the City of Pelham.

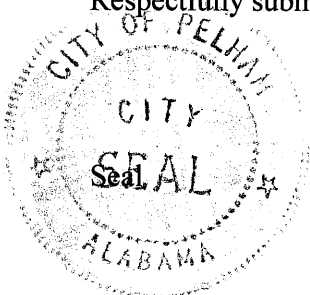
Each councilmember had an opportunity to question Mayor Murphy and the department heads in attendance.

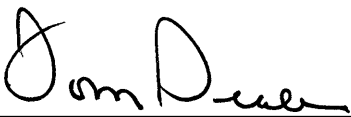
