

Pelham Beautification Board
January 4, 2010 Minutes

The Pelham Beautification Board met on January 4, 2010 at Pelham City Hall. The meeting was called to order by Vice President Mosely Johnson at 6:13 p.m.

Members present: Mosely Johnson, Darlene Webb, Kathy Lee, Marsha Yates

Darlene read the minutes from the October 16, 2009 meeting and made a motion to approve. Mosely seconded the motion and the minutes were approved as read.

Old Business: Mosely commented on the tree lighting and the Christmas decoration judging.

New Business: It was decided Mosely would make the presentation to the winners of the Best Decorated Christmas Contest at the city council meeting tonight. We arranged the award certificates in the order they would be presented along with the Pelham glass mugs.

The board discussed Pelham Pride Day, and Mosely informed us that Betsy Whitfield had agreed to chair it again this year. Marsha reported that Councilmember Teresa Nichols had lined up a free electronic recycling program for April 17 and recommended that Pelham Pride Day be the same day. The board agreed to wait until the February meeting to finalize the date in order to coordinate with Waste Management to try and have the annual Spring Clean-up Day and Pelham Pride Day on the same Saturday.

Marsha researched past minutes and reported the Police Officer Award for litter prevention in Pelham was awarded in April 2009 and recommended we award the 2010 award again in April.
