

Pelham Beautification Board
May 6, 2010 Minutes

The Pelham Beautification Board met on May 6, 2010 at Pelham City Hall. The meeting was called to order by President Betsy Whitfield at 6:35 p.m.

Members present: Betsy Whitfield, Neville Peacock, Cheryl Fulton, Marsha Yates (no quorum)

The April 15, 2010 minutes were read, and Cheryl moved to approve as written. Neville seconded the motion, and the minutes were accepted as submitted.

Old Business:

Members present discussed Pelham Pride Day and made notes of things to address for next year: first aid kit at the pavilion, assure each team has a responsible adult to lead them, delay giving out prizes until 11:00 when all teams are present, place a pen in the team bags with the sign-in sheet, have teams meet at 8:45, have a separate sign-in sheet for the various groups cleaning at the park (age 10 and under), provide a recycle bag for drink cans, assign someone to monitor the ice and drinks and order fewer hot dogs.

New Business:

Marsha shared that the city may cut back on the public relations budget for next year, which could affect money allowed for pride day tee shirts and Christmas ornaments. The budget will be submitted to the council in September and we will know what we have to spend once the council passes it. Members present discussed alternative give-a-ways should the budget be cut.

The following businesses were entered for consideration of the June commercial award:

These areas were entered for consideration of the June residential award:

Neville made a motion to continue giving a Beautification Board Award to the Pelham Police officer giving out the most citations for littering, and Cheryl seconded. All present agreed. Marsha will ask the court magistrate to tally up last year's citations and give us the name of the officer to be awarded. We will have a plaque made to present at a council meeting.

We considered the fact that all board members roll off end of September 2010, and discussed if we knew of any members not wishing to be reappointed. Cheryl stated she needed to give up her position due to time needed for her children.

Members present decided the board will not meet during the summer. The meeting time was changed back to 6:00. Members will be contacted once a date for the Police Award presentation is set.

The next board meeting will be September 2, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. at city hall.
