Karyl Rice moved to approve the minutes of the December 18, 1989, meeting as written. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

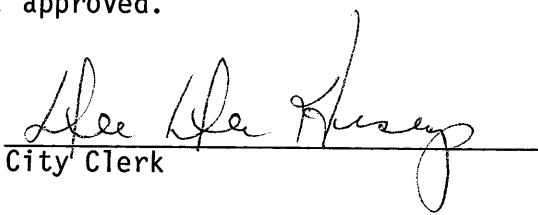
There was no old business to come before the Council.
