Jim Phillips moved to approve the minutes of the February 5, 1990, meeting as written. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

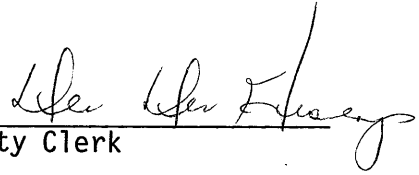
There was no old business to come before the Council.
