There was no old business to come before the Council.

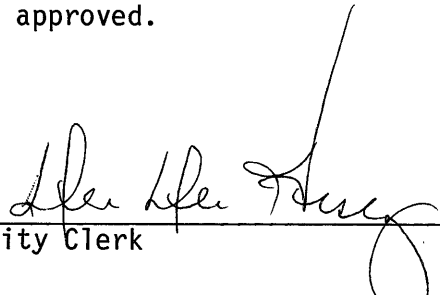
