Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

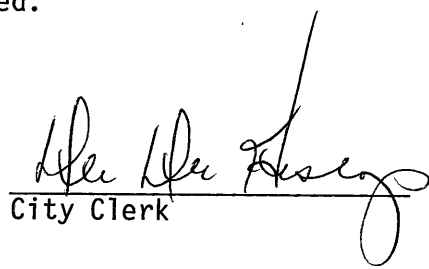

Mayor Hayes introduced a resolution advancing \$300 to Barbara Roberts while attending the State Library Convention at Orange Beach, Alabama, April 24-27, 1990. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced approving one street light at David Green Drive and Highway 31 and one street light at North Chandalar and Richmond Circle. Karyl Rice moved to approve the installation of both lights. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
