Connie LaBue seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all council members present voting yes. Thereupon Karyl Rice moved to approve the ordinance as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

A public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-13 rezoning property located adjacent to Valley Commerce Park on County Road 33 from A-1 Agricultural District to B-2 General Business District. Connie LaBue moved that said ordinance be approved. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-14 rezoning property located adjacent to Valley Commerce Park on County Road 33 from A-1 Agricultural to B-2 General Business District. Connie LaBue moved to approve the ordinance as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Willard Payne moved to reschedule the May 21, 1990, Council Meeting to May 29, 1990, due to the Alabama League meeting.
