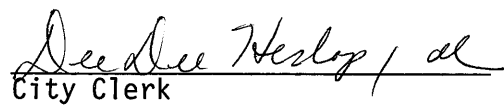
Karyl Rice moved to approve the June 4, 1990 minutes as written. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
