

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., July 2, 1990. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order. Ken Maynard opened the meeting with prayer. A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present except Willard Payne.

Connie Labue moved to approve the minutes of the June 18, 1990 meeting as written. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced authorizing the city to install a street light at Chatham Court. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business Connie LaBue announced three public hearings to be held July 16, 1990. 1) To consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City of Pelham so as to change subject zoning from the present zoning of R-1, Residential District to A-1, Agricultural District. The property is located at 380 Highway 361; applicants - Mr. L. A. Wilkinson and Mrs. Mary Alice Wilkinson. 2) To consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City of Pelham so as to change subject zoning from the present zoning of A-1, Agricultural District to B-2, General Business District and R-2, Multiple Dwelling District. The property is located at 3131 Helena Road; applicant - Mrs. Ruth Davis. 3) To consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City of Pelham so as to change subject zoning from the present zoning of R-1, Single Family District to R-2, Multiple Dwelling District. The property is located behind Royal Oaks Subdivision; applicants - Mr. Thomas Stubbs and Mr. Harold Walker.

With no other business before the Council, Ken Maynard moved to adjourn. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
