During New Business, a resolution advancing \$450.00 to Chief Wade and Captain Thomas to cover expenses while attending the Regional Retraining of the FBI National Academy in Gulf Shores on August 1-3, 1990 was introduced. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution advancing \$100 to Bill Overstreet for expenses while attending a Personnel Conference July 28-August 1, 1990, in Point Clear, Alabama was introduced. Connie LaBue moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution advancing \$200 to Daphne Holler for expenses while attending a State & Local Business Licensing Conference July 26-27, 1990 in New Orleans, Louisiana was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced authorizing the City to have Alabama Power install two street light on Sykes Street. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A street light request from Robert P. Ball for Ridge Drive was presented. Mayor Hayes asked Paul Yeager to investigate and make a recommendation at the next meeting.

Chief Gary Waters and Firefighter Mike Harris addressed the Council inviting them to attend the Alabama Association of Fire Chiefs 40th Annual Conference and the Alabama Firefighter's Association convention.

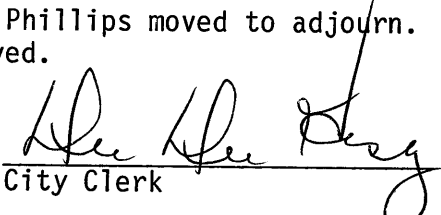
Connie LaBue announced three public hearings for the August 6, 1990 Council Meeting.

A public hearing was held to consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City of Pelham so as to change subject zoning from the present zoning of R-1, Single Family District to R-2, Multiple Dwelling District. The property is located behind Royal Oaks Subdivision and owned by Mr. Thomas Stubbs and Mr. Harold Walker. Mr. Paul James spoke against the rezoning request. Connie LaBue announced that the Planning and Zoning Board recommended not rezoning the property. Ms. LaBue moved to deny the request. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

A public hearing was held to consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City so as to change subject zoning from the present zoning of A-1, Agricultural District to B-2, General Business Dwelling District. The property is located at 3131 Helena Road and the applicant was Mrs. Ruth Davis. Connie LaBue moved to deny the request. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A public hearing was held to consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City so as to change subject zoning from the present zoning of R-1, Residential District to A-1, Agricultural District. The property is located at 380 Highway 361 and the owners are Mr. L. A. Wilkinson and Mrs. Mary Alice Wilkinson. Connie LaBue moved to approve the request as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the Council, Jim Phillips moved to adjourn. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
