

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., August 20, 1990. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order. Willard Payne opened the meeting with prayer. A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present.

Willard Payne moved to approve the minutes of the August 6, 1990 meeting as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

During Old Business, Ordinance No. 135-20 was introduced rezoning property located on Highway 11 across the street from Acme Paper from A-1 Agricultural District to M-2 Heavy Industrial District. The applicants were Charlene Quinn and J. A. Brown. Connie LaBue moved to approve the ordinance as written. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

During New Business a resolution was introduced authorizing the city to begin collecting city sales tax effective October 1, 1990, and to notify the State of their decision. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced advancing \$200 to cover the cost of meals and gasoline for Lt. Florence and Sgt. Delk while attending the U. S. Attorney's Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee Seminar on "Gangs" scheduled September 12-14, 1990 in Gulf Shores, Alabama. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented, Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution approving a street light at Church Street and Highway 52 West was presented. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as written. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Billy Hill addressed the Council on behalf of the Shelby Emergency Assistance Program asking for consideration in this year's budget.

With no other business before the Council, Jim Phillips moved to adjourn. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
