

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., September 10, 1990. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order. Karyl Rice opened the meeting with prayer. A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present except Jim Phillips.

An application for Retail beer (on or off premises) was introduced. The applicant was Mr. Allen Walker Sides doing business as Pig Sickle. Karyl Rice moved to table discussion until the next council meeting. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all council members voting yes.

An application for transfer of liquor license from location to location for Alabama Wholesale Wines was introduced. Willard Payne moved to approve the application as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the Council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
