

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., October 1, 1990. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order. Willard Payne opened the meeting with prayer. A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present.

Karyl Rice moved to approve the minutes of the September 15, 1990 meeting as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no old business to come before the Council.

During new business, Mayor Hayes presented the 1990 - 1991 budget. Ken Maynard moved to approve the budget as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 209 annexing property along Highway 119 was presented. Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all members approving the suspension of the rules. Willard Payne moved to approve Ordinance No. 209 as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 210 annexing Abele property was presented. Willard Payne moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all members approving the suspension of the rules. Connie LaBue moved to approve Ordinance No. 210 as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 211 annexing Summerall and Webster property was introduced. Willard Payne moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all members of the Council approving the suspension of the rules. Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 211 as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

An application for Lounge Retail Liquor - Class II was presented for Promenade Package Store. Jim Phillips moved to approve the application as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and the motion passed 5-1.

A resolution approving plans for Alabama State Highway Project ACIR-65-2 (126) Sites #2 and #3 was presented. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution entering into an agreement with the State of Alabama Highway Department for traffic signal/street lighting on AL 119 at State Park Road; I-65 Southbound off-ramp at AL 119; and I-65 Northbound off-ramp at AL 119 was presented. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution advancing \$250 to Alan Salter while attending the National Recreation and Parks Association Congress October 10-15, 1990 in Phoenix, Arizona was introduced. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

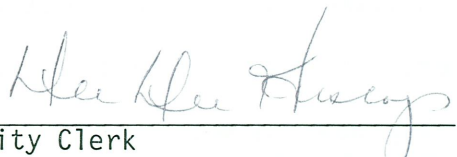
A public hearing was held to consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City to change zoning from A-1 Agricultural District to M-2 Heavy Industrial District. The property location is adjacent to McCain Industrial Park and the owners are Douglas Pardue and Norman Pardue. Connie LaBue moved to approve the rezoning as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A vote was taken and all members of the Council approved the rezoning, Ordinance No. 135-21.

Ann Speakman addressed the Council concerning animal control for the City.

Wayne Rawlinson addressed the Council concerning the weed and debris ordinance. He asked that the city clean the easement by his home. The Council agreed to his request.

Connie LaBue announced two public hearings to be held October 15, 1990; applicants - Harvey and Paula Coker and 119 Properties, Ltd.
