

The Pelham City Council convened November 19, 1990 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Willard Payne opened with prayer. A roll call was taken with all Council Members present.

Jim Phillips moved to approve the November 5, 1990 minutes as written. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no old business to come before the Council.

During new business a resolution to advance \$250 to Alan Salter while attending the Athletic Business Conference in Anaheim, California December 5-6, 1990 was introduced. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution advancing \$360 to Barbara Roberts while attending the Southeast Library Convention in Nashville, Tennessee December 4-8, 1990 was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 182-1 amending the tennis court ordinance was introduced and will be voted on at the next council meeting.

Ordinance No. 214 annexing Daniel B. Whitman property was introduced. Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all council members voting yes. Thereupon Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 214 as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

A transfer application for retail beer on premise for Sgt. Pelhams Deli & Pub was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to deny the request. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and the motion carried three to two.

A public hearing for December 10, 1990 was announced to consider rezoning property from R-1 Residential to Special District. The applicants are Harvey and Paula Coker.

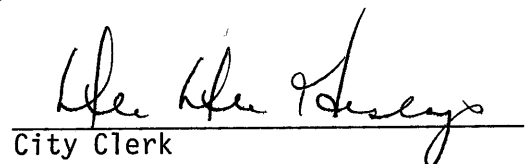
Mayor Hayes announced a street light request for 3513 Wildwood Drive and ask the City Engineer to investigate and report to the Council at the next meeting.
