Jim Phillips seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all members of the Council voting to suspend the rules. Thereupon Willard Payne moved to approve Ordinance 215 as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

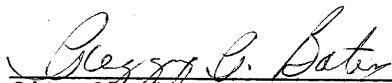

Karyl Rice seconded the motion. The application was approved with a vote of three to two.

An application for retail table wine (on & off premises) for Sgt. Pelhams was presented. Jim Phillips moved to approve the application as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and it carried three to two.

Ken Maynard moved to appoint Judy Byram to the Park Board to fill the unexpired term of Martha Hightower. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

Mr. Levin Perry presented a request for annexation. Willard Payne moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration of Ordinance No. 216 annexing the Perry property. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all Council Members voting to suspend the rules. Thereupon Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 216 as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the Council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
