During new business, Ordinance No. 218 deannexing U. S. Steel property adjoining Royal Oaks was introduced. Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration of the ordinance. Willard Payne seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all members present voting yes. Thereupon Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 218 as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

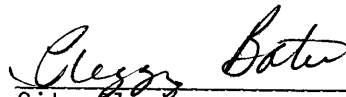

Mayor Hayes announced a public hearing to be held April 15, 1991 to consider rezoning property on 261 from A-1 to Special District. The applicant is Mr. Red Hulon.
