Ken Maynard moved to approve the May 6, 1991 minutes as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

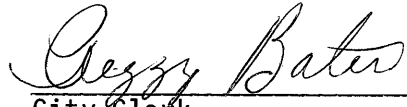
There was no old business to come before the Council.
