

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., June 17, 1991. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Ken Maynard opened with prayer. A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present except Jim Phillips.

Ken Maynard moved to approve the June 3, 1991 minutes as written. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business Mayor Hayes gave an update on a possible noise ordinance, stating that we had received several ordinances from other municipalities for review.

During new business, a street light request was presented for the Chandalar Subdivision. Ken Maynard moved to approve the request to maintain lighting expense for 33 street lights to be installed by Alabama Power. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes introduced a resolution designating June 21 to honor Desert Shield/Desert Storm servicemen, women and their families and encouraged everyone to show their support by flying their flags on that day.

A street light request for Ridge Drive was presented. Mayor Hayes stated that Mike Morgan would be asked to investigate the need for a light at that location and report to the Council at their next meeting.

A resolution advancing \$435 to Captain E. A Thomas and Lt. A. S. Florence while attending the Regional Organized Crime Information Center Conference June 24-27, 1991 in Greenville, South Carolina and \$410 to cover expenses for Barbara Roberts while attending the American Library Association Convention June 28-July 1, 1991 in Atlanta, Georgia was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

Mr. Tom Timmons, President of Pelham Friends of the Library, addressed the Council giving them an opportunity to join the organization.

With no other business before the Council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.
