There was no old business to come before the Council.

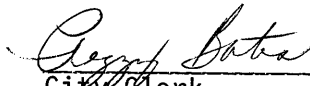

Connie LaBue announced a public hearing to be held August 5, 1991 to consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries to change present zoning from R-3 Multiple Dwelling District to Special District on property located off Wellington Drive. The applicant is Mr. Bill McKenzie.

Paul Yeager requested approval of a Quit Claim Deed for property located at 2620 Chandalar Lane, Lot 28; owners - R. H. & Patricia McCrary. Ken Maynard moved to approve the deed as requested. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.
