

The Pelham City Council convened September 9, 1991 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Willard Payne opened with prayer. A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present except Jim Phillips.

Karyl Rice moved to approve the August 19, 1991 minutes as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business Paul Yeager recommended that a street light be installed at Glenview Avenue, Pole No. 292. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution authorizing the installation of a street light on Glenview Avenue, Pole No. 292. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business a resolution accepting a bid for handicap construction was presented. Ken Maynard moved to approve the low bid of \$19,940 from Hulon Construction to make City Hall accessible to the handicapped. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution calling for the redemption and payment of \$2,000,000 in General Obligation Warrants was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as written. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution calling for the redemption and payment of \$2,215,000 in General Obligation Water Warrants was introduced. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as written. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 223 providing for the issuance of \$5,775,000 of General Obligation Warrants was introduced. Karyl Rice moved that the rules be suspended and that unanimous consent be given for immediate consideration of and action on said ordinance, which motion was seconded by Willard Payne, and upon the motion being put to vote, the following vote was recorded: Yeas - Mayor Hayes, Ken Maynard, Connie LaBue, Willard Payne and Karyl Rice; Nays - none. Thereupon Ken Maynard moved that said ordinance be adopted, which motion was seconded by Connie LaBue and upon the motion being put to vote, the ordinance was adopted unanimously.

An application for retail beer sales (on and off premises) for Oak Mountain State Park was introduced. Willard Payne moved to approve the application as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

An application for Lounge Retail Liquor Class II for H & M Package Store (transfer) was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to approve the application as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved with one council member abstaining.

With no other business before the Council, Karyl Rice moved to adjourn. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.
