

The Pelham City Council convened October 7, 1991 at 7:00 p.m. Karyl Rice opened the meeting with prayer. A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present.

Karyl Rice moved to approve the September 16, 1991 minutes as written. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business, Paul Yeager reported on the cost of a blinking light for North Chandalar Drive. Mr. Yeager did not recommend the light due to the cost and liability to the city. He suggested the street department run a survey for a four way stop sign.

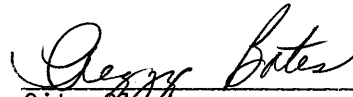
