

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m. October 21, 1991. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Willard Payne opened with prayer.

A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present except Jim Phillips.

Willard Payne moved to approve the October 7, 1991, minutes as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

During Old Business Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 67-2 revising building codes and fees. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business an application for transfer of liquor license for Promenade Package Store was presented. Willard Payne moved to approve the transfer. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced authorizing the following board appointments: Judy Braym to the Park & Recreation Board for a six year term; John Battles to the Planning Commission for a six year term; Dan Spitler, Jackie Williams, Anita Latham, Richard McPherson and John McDonald to the Industrial Development Board for six year terms; and Hollis Hendrix and John Chapin to the Board of Adjustments for three year terms. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution authorizing Alabama Power to bill the city for street lights in Cahaba Valley Park was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution appointing Judy Milner, Safety Coordinator was introduced. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes reported that the sales tax for mobile homes will remain at 2% as recommended by Revenue Director, Mike Morgan.

With no other business before the Council, Connie LaBue moved to adjourn. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.
