

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m. Monday, November 4, 1991. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Karyl Rice opened with prayer. A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present except Willard Payne.

Ken Maynard moved to approve the October 21, 1991, minutes as written. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business Paul Yeager reported on a traffic study at Wildewood Drive stating, as previously discussed, an activated signal would cost approximately \$10,000. He was against doing anything.

During new business a stop sign request at Wildewood Drive and North Chandalar Drive was discussed. It was decided that the grade at the top of the hill was too steep for a stop sign.

A resolution authorizing Alabama Power to install four street lights in Phase V of Stratford Place was presented. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
