A resolution appointing Peggy Bates to perform election duties was introduced. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 225 setting poll hours was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved. Thereupon, Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 225 as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and the ordinance was unanimously passed.

Ordinance No. 166-1 setting qualification fees was introduced. Ken Maynard moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved. Thereupon, Willard Payne moved to approve Ordinance No. 166-1 as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

An application for a restaurant retail liquor license for Challangers was presented. Jim Phillips moved to approve the application as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and the application was approved with a 3 to 2 vote.
