A roll call was taken with all members of the Council present.

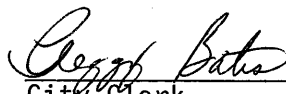
Ken Maynard moved to approve the February 17, 1992, minutes as written. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.
