A roll call was taken with all members present except Jim Phillips.

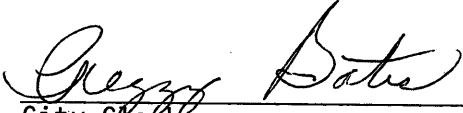
Karyl Rice moved to approve the May 11, 1992 minutes as written. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
