Willard Payne moved to approve the July 20, 1992, minutes as written. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

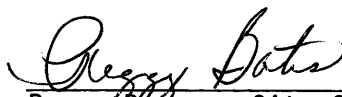
There was no old business to come before the Council.
