A resolution was presented to accept lighting responsibility for two decorative street lights in Royhl Chase with the developer paying installation cost. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business, Ordinance No. 231 establishing a garbage fee was introduced. Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration of said ordinance. Thereupon Jim Phillips moved to adopt ordinance #231 as written. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes presented the City of Pelham budget for 1992-93. Ken Maynard moved to approve the budget as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was presented advancing \$1,000 to Sgt. Larry Palmer during his attendance at the Narcotics Supervision Seminar scheduled October 14-16, 1992, in Reno, Nevada. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was presented advancing \$200 to Lt. A. S. Florence during his attendance at the FBI Southeastern Law Enforcement Executive Development Seminar scheduled October 18-23, 1992, at Joe Wheeler State Park. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

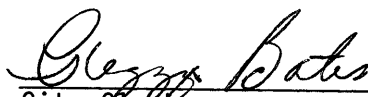
