

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, November 2, 1992.

Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Ken Maynard opened with prayer. Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members present except Jim Phillips.

Connie LaBue moved to approve the October 19, 1992 minutes as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no old business to come before the Council.

During new business George Holcomb gave an update on Shelby County Solid Waste and announced a meeting to be held November 9, 1992 at 7:00 p.m. to discuss the county's solid waste program.

Ordinance No. 135-32 adopting the zoning map dated February 1992 was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved. Thereupon Karyl Rice moved and Willard Payne seconded the move that the ordinance be approved. The ordinance passed unanimously.

A resolution advancing \$250.00 to Judy Milner while attending the Fundamentals of Human Resource Management course at Auburn, Alabama, November 18-20, 1992, was introduced. Connie LaBue moved to approve the resolution as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

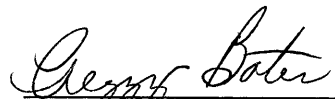
An application for Lounge Retail Liquor CL II was introduced for the Warehouse Bottle Shop. John Burleson stated that he wanted an off premise license and would reapply. Dr. Mike Shaw asked to be notified of the hearing.

Barbara Adams of Little Oak Ridge Estates addressed the council with concerns about traffic entering businesses at the foot of the hill. She cited the danger of the blind curve and people parking along the road. The owner of the day care spoke about the problem. Mayor Hayes stated that he would talk to the developer and the city engineer to find a solution.

A street light request for Yeager Circle was introduced. Mayor Hayes stated the city engineer would be asked to evaluate whether a light is needed and would report at the next meeting.

A resolution appointing Tillman Everson and Laura Willis to a six year term on the Industrial Development Board was introduced. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the Council Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
