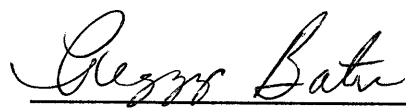
Willard Payne moved to approve the January 18, 1993, minutes as written. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.
