

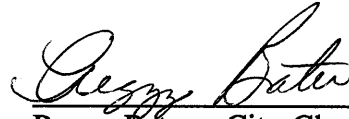
The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, July 19, 1993. Mayor Pro Tem Ken Maynard called the meeting to order. Karyl Rice gave the invocation. Mr. Maynard asked that the record show all members of the Council present except Mayor Hayes.

Connie LaBue moved to approve the minutes of the July 12, 1993, meeting as written. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

During old business, a public hearing was held to consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City of Pelham changing the present zoning of A-1 Agricultural to Special District on property located off Highway 52 owned by Bobby Hinds. Robert Farmer represented Mr. Hinds and the developer Steve Mobley. He presented a preliminary map of the development and explained the use of the property. Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-40 rezoning said property. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved. Connie LaBue abstained from voting.

During new business, a resolution appointing Red Hulon to a four year term on the Board of Adjustments & Appeals was presented. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the Council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
