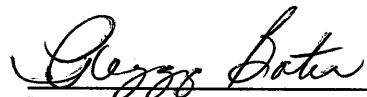
Karyl Rice announced the following public hearings.

1) A public hearing to be held September 13, 1993, at 7:00 p.m. to consider an amendment to the City of Pelham Zoning Ordinance amending Art. XII-B, B-4 General Business District, Sec. 2, so as to add paragraph 2. to read - Any use permitted in the B-3 General Business District.

2) A public hearing to be held September 13, 1993, at 7:00 p.m., to consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City of Pelham changing the present zoning of B-2 General Business District to B-4 General Business District on property located at 2805 Montgomery Highway (U. S. 31 and Ridge Drive). Applicant - Steve Issis.
