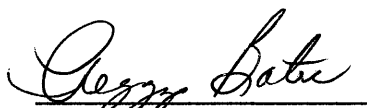
Ken Maynard moved to approve the September 20, 1993 minutes as written. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
