An application for retail beer and retail wine, on and off premise, for Johnny Ray's was introduced. Jim Phillips moved to approve the request as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

An application for retail beer and retail table wine, off premise, for Marketplace Amoco #9 was presented. Connie LaBue moved to approve the request as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and it carried with a five to one vote.

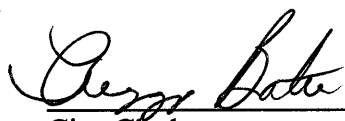
An application for restaurant retail liquor for Cock of the Walk was presented. Jim Phillips moved to approve the request. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
