Karyl Rice moved to approve the July 18, 1994 minutes as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

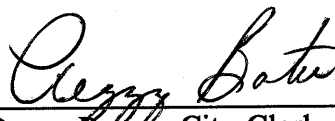

Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.
