Ken Maynard moved to approve the October 17 minutes as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

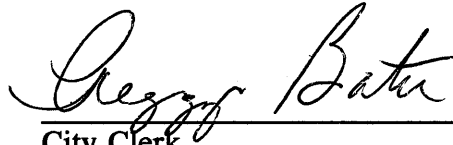
During old business a public hearing was held to consider rezoning property off King Valley Road from R-1 Residential to Special District. The applicant was Roy Martin. No one spoke for or against the rezoning. Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 134-43 rezoning the property as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A public hearing was held to consider rezoning property off Highway 33 from B-2 General Business to R-3 Multiple Dwelling. The applicant was A. C. McGuire. No one was present to speak for or against the rezoning. Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-55 rezoning the property as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business, a resolution advancing \$250 to Karen Bragan to cover expenses while attending Municipal Court School in Tuscaloosa, November 14-16 was presented. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

An application for retail beer and retail table wine, off premise, was presented for Tidmore Oil Company d/b/a Coosa Mart. Willard Payne moved to approve the application as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and it passed with a four to one vote.

With no other business before the council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
